

## CIETT MEMBERSHIP FEES FOR 2009 FOR NATIONAL FEDERATIONS

### PRINCIPLE

#### Criteria

3 combined criteria:

- National daily average number of Agency Workers (FTE)
- GDP per capita
- Total population of country

For each criteria, a scale attributes points according to statistics on a national level

Daily average number of Agency Workers (FTE)	
< 200,000	1 point
200,000 to 499,999	2 points
500,000 to 2,000,000	3 points
> 2,000,000	4 points

GDP per capita \$	
< 5,000	1 point
5,000 to 14,999	2 points
15,000 to 30,000	3 points
> 30,000	4 points

Total population	
< 20 million	1 point
20 to 39 million	2 points
40 to 200 million	3 points
> 200 million	4 points

#### Classes of National Federations

4 classes of National Federations, with fixed fees contribution based on the total number of points\*

Class A	€ 1,056	3 to 5 points
Class B	€ 2,639	6 to 8 points
Class C	€ 10,557	9 to 10 points
Class D	€ 17,947	11 to 12 points

\* In case of several National Federations represent the same country within Ciett, the total amount of fees is split up between the number of federations
